Eligible for reimbursement up to the maximum amount based on completion of an approved learning plan.	Allows flexibility between parent programming around some subject areas (usually options). Eligible for partial reimbursement based on agreement with Home-Based Coordinator and submission of an approved plan for courses the parent is providing.
<p>Note: <u>Shared responsibility programming</u>- For parents who wish for their child to be enrolled with Home-Based School for a portion of the day, but attend their designated school as well. This discussion begins with the principal at the designated school. The principal, in discussion with the parent, will decide if such a program is possible within the scheduling of their day and then, which courses can be done in their building and which would be done at home. In most of these cases, the at-home courses are provided in a teacher directed format (Option A). The principal then communicates with Home-Based School about the arrangement. All communication about these courses is then shared with the school.</p>
